The 4 elements to your course

1 Skills bootcamp

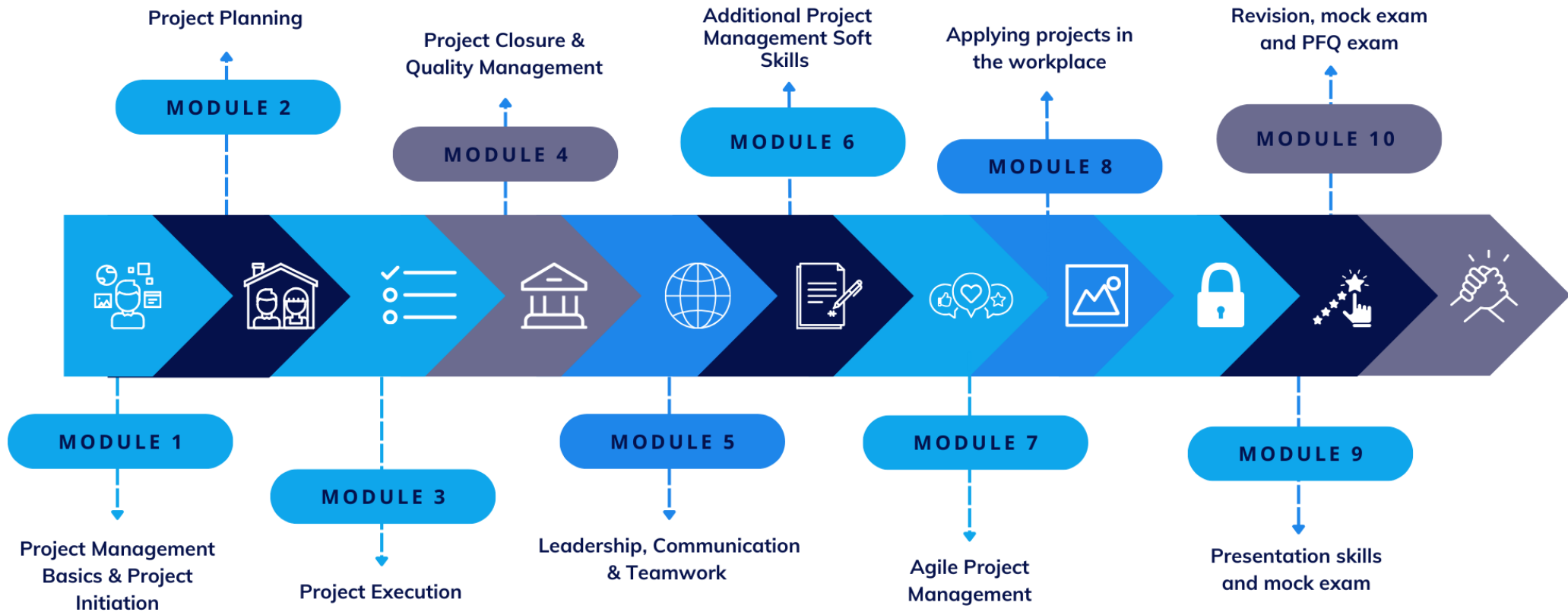
4 Success!

Eligibility

To be eligible for funding, you must:

- ✓ Be aged 19 or older
- ✓ Have the right to work in the UK
- ✓ Live in Hampshire
- ✓ Have not started a Skills Bootcamp in last 12 months
- ✓ Have maintained UK residency for the last 3 years



Course costs

- If you are unemployed or self-employed with no employees the course is free!
- If you have 1 or more employees you must contribute 10% of the course cost which is £276.00
- If you have 250+ employees you must contribute 30% of the course cost which is £828.00
