- Candidates should be working in a role where they are identifying learning / training needs, designing / sourcing training and learning solutions, delivering and evaluating training, and working with stakeholder / business area managers.
- The entry requirement for this apprenticeship will be decided by each employer but may typically be five GCSEs at grade C or higher.
