Entry Requirements:

- The entry requirement for this apprenticeship will be decided by each employer but may typically be five GCSEs at Grade C or higher.
- A Practitioner will typically lead smaller projects and/or play a key supporting role in a larger programme.

Overview:

The Improvement Practitioner qualification is suitable for those who lead small projects or play a key/ supporting role in a larger program. Covering issues that may require quick solutions, or challenges that are re-occurring and require more in-depth analysis. During this qualification, you will learn about coaching teams, sharing best practices and supporting the application of such techniques to ensure prioritization of the customer.

Key Topics:

- Team formation and leadership, project selection and scope.
- Project management, compliance, presentation and reporting.
